Clean Air Day – 21 June 2018

[Clean Air Day](#) is co-ordinated by [Global Action Plan](#) and is a chance to find out more about air pollution, share information and help make our air cleaner and healthier for everyone.

Why Living Streets supports Clean Air Day

Air pollution currently contributes to 40,000 premature deaths a year in the UK. The biggest source of this dirty air is motorised traffic, so encouraging people out of their cars to walk more of their everyday, local journeys has to be part of the solution.

For example, did you know that **one in four cars** at peak times in the morning are on the school run? By making our streets safer and nicer places to walk and encouraging families to walk to school, we can help improve local air quality.

How we support Clean Air Day

[Last year](#), we took to the streets on Clean Air Day in Birmingham, Leeds, London and Manchester to spread the word about how we can all help reduce pollution. This year, we'll be doing more of the same through our work with various partners, schools and businesses. Speak to your Living Streets Coordinator to see what's going on where you are. We'll also be sharing what we're up to on [Twitter](#) and [Instagram, using the #CleanAirDay hashtag](#).

How you can get involved

- Walk with us! We want to encourage people to leave their cars at home and join us in being part of the solution to the UK's air pollution problem. Help lead the way by leaving your car at home on Clean Air Day.
- Research from Living Streets (May '18) showed that air pollution is an increasing concern amongst parents, with 1 in 3 UK parents considering air pollution levels when choosing their child's school and over a fifth holding the misconception that children are protected from air pollution inside the car. Encourage parents to [download our Family Walk to School Kit](#), full of ideas and advice on how to make the walk to school safer and more enjoyable, so they're encouraged to give walking a go for Clean Air Day.
- Living Streets also works in workplaces and communities to help people of all ages walk more, [visit livingstreets.org.uk/what-we-do/](#) to find out how we could help your colleagues and communities take to their feet.

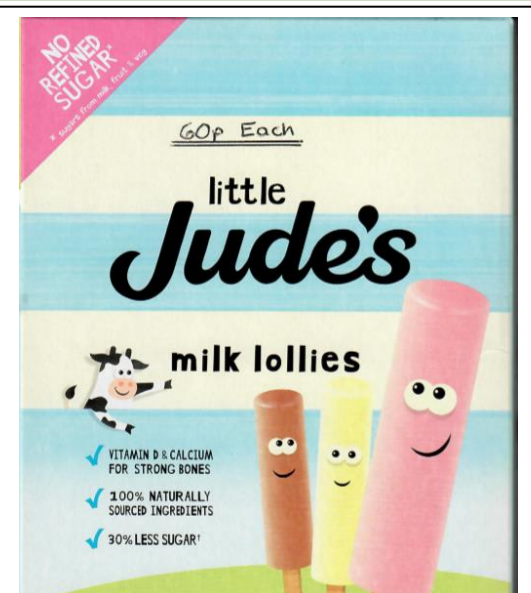

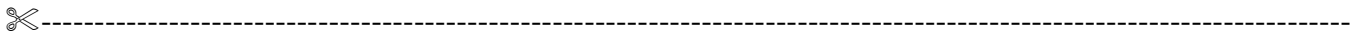
