The school is looking to appoint 3 friendly and caring individuals to join our school team. Our lunchtime supervisors undertake a most important role within school and for this we are keen to appoint the right individuals. We require approachable, friendly and flexible members of staff one to work for 6.25 hours per week, 12.15 – 1.30pm Monday to Friday and two casual to work the same hours but on an adhoc basis as and when required. The successful applicants will be expected to:

- Working under the direction and instruction of senior staff provide the care of the children during the school lunch break.
- Escorting pupils to and from the school dining room
- Supervision of children before, during and after the meal
- Supervision of children bringing sandwiches
- Summoning help, where necessary, in case of injury or illness and providing basic first aid for minor injuries (for which training will be available)
- Assisting the children with their table manners and use of cutlery, and assisting with the cutting of meat etc. for smaller children
- Patrolling the playground and “out of bounds” areas regularly
- Organising games and activities
- Assisting with the clearing of the school hall at the end of lunch
- This school is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people/vulnerable adults and expect all staff and volunteers to share this commitment.
