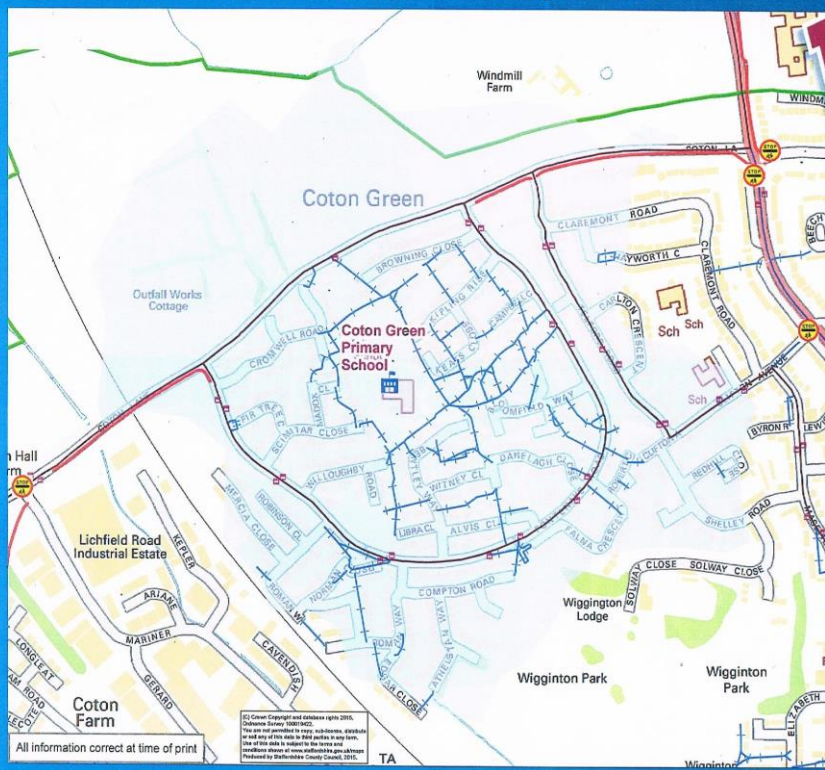
The **10 Minute Walk Zone** has been introduced at your school to encourage as many families as possible to walk either all or part of the way to and from school. The benefits of walking to school are:

- ★ It's healthy for adults and children.
- ★ It teaches children road safety.
- ★ It's easier than finding a parking space outside school.
- ★ It's better for the environment.
- ★ It helps keep the roads around school free from traffic which is safer for all our children.
- ★ It's fun to walk and talk!

If you do need to travel by car, please park outside the **10 Minute Walk Zone**. Our map will help you plan a route to school.



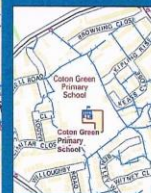
**Travelling to Coton Green Primary School**



If you live inside the 10 Minute Zone, you could walk to and from school every day. Even if you need a car to travel to work, it may be quicker and easier to leave it parked at home while you do the school run.

If you live just outside the Zone, try walking – it could be quicker than you think!

If you have to travel by car to school, please try to park outside the walking zone, with care and consideration for local residents, and walk the rest of the way.

We have had another very musical time at school this week with performances from our Y3 Violinists, Y5 Ukuleles and our Lower School Songbirds Choir.

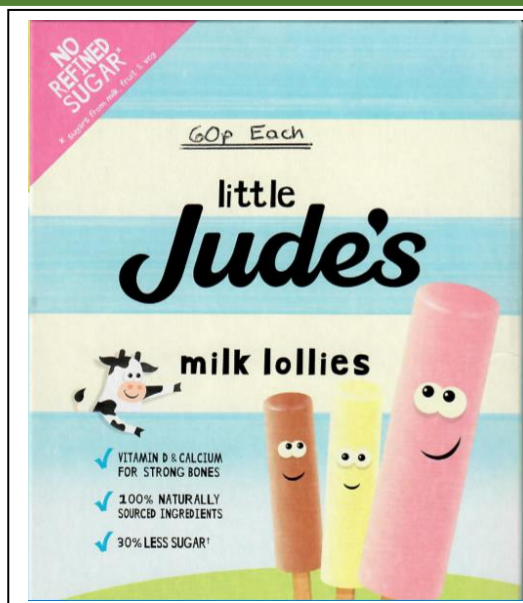

## Tamworth AC Startrack

### Children's Summer Athletics

Tamworth AC Startrack is open to children aged 8 -15 and will be held over 3 days from Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> –Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> July 2018.

Children will take part in a range of athletic events between 10:00am – 3:00pm over the three days. Essential equipment is shorts, T shirt and trainers, and children will need to bring a packed lunch (The club tuck shop will be open for drinks and confectionery at lunch time) and suitable clothing in case it rains.

Startrack is limited to 50 places and will be allocated on a first come first served basis. The cost of the event is £35 for three days.

(Please note that sponsorship from Aviva had allowed us to provide goody bags with a free tee shirt in previous years. This will not be possible in 2018).

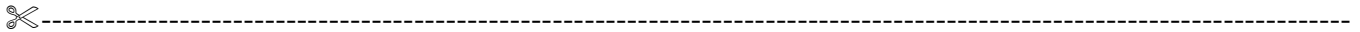
